Food for the Mob On-Country Kitchen

The ABC Foundation delivered a mobile meal service to address food insecurity in the region, as well as delivering commercial on-site indigenous catering, training and employment for disengaged Aboriginal people and youth.

While the project initially focused on reducing food waste from Carnarvon plantations to create low-cost healthy meals, the ABC Foundation also provided emergency relief in conjunction with their community partners across the Gascoyne and Mid-West regions during Covid-19. In total they provided over 26,000 hot meals at no cost and additional low-cost meals to those experiencing food insecurity.
